
JOHNNY MELVILLE WORKSHOPS

Johnny Melville's academic qualifications complement 45 years of a huge range of theatrical and film experience across

all five continents, in more than 40 countries. At home as mime, singer, actor, clown, director and writer he has been called Comic Superma (Zurich Tages Anzeiger) L'enfant terrible of the Fools movement (Berti Hahn, German theatre manager), and even Funniest guy in the World (Danish radio) Known for performing a of one man series shows, recently he has been making and appearing in films at

Workshop Description

A workshop with Johnny Melville is an intensive & delightfully physical course of comic theatre specializing in mimicry, improvisation, spontaneity, and the understanding of energy - in fact how to live the nouveau - clown. The course features a potpourri of training disciplines taken from martial arts (aikido, Tai Chi, Chi-Gong, Kalari), mime, clown, acrobatics, dance and the world of the chimpanzee, whose agility and flexibility can lead the actor to function better with breath and relaxation. Johnny uses a variety of games to inspire imagination and play, at the same time bringing awareness to transform the student's negative programming into his/her sovereign potential. Children's games, trust exercises, group sensitivity-work together with improvisation and character development all integrate with the physical study freeing the actor from mechanical responses and therefore able to step more easily into genuine creativity. Each workshop culminates with Johnny leading the group in an improvised street performance.



Themes

- Group building and sensitivity exercises
- Energy in spontaneity, performance dynamics and improvisation
- Falling, stage fighting and comedy acrobatics
- Character study
- Mime and the theory of spatial relation
- Street performance
- Individual sketch development
- Group sketch development





Various techniques used in class

- Introduction to body disciplines aikido, tai chi, chi gong, kalaripayattu & yoga
- Breathing as a tool for relaxation
- Relaxation in relation to energy chimpanzee training an ideal tool for the actor
- Exercises taken from children's games, theatre lab, mime and various modes of improvisation (Influences Carlos Castaneda, Joseph Chaikin, Meyerhold's bio-mechanics, Keith Johnstone, Eugenio Barba, The Liverpool George St Project, etc.)
- Negative resistance of the ego
- Positive resistance and how to utilize it as a form of expression
- Body and inner mental work in character building
- Clown techniques in dance, acrobatics, falls



Workshop requirements

- A room that is warm, and with sufficient natural light
- A wooden floor is the ideal
- Acrobatic mats
- Any actor in training should have loose clothes for physical work.
- Students should be fragrance-free of chemical detergents, both them and their clothing.
